**IAEA CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENT AUTHORITY

This certifies that the source described has been demonstrated to meet the regulatory requirements for special form radioactive material as prescribed in the regulations of the International Atomic Energy Agency¹ and the United States of America² for the transport of radioactive materials.

1. Source Identification - Alpha-Omega Services, Inc. Model CSN0010-192 Brachytherapy Source.
2. Source Description - Cylindrical seal welded single encapsulation made of Type 316L stainless steel with a welded connector and 7x7 stranded stainless steel cable extension. Approximate exterior dimensions of the capsule are 1.1 mm (0.04 in.) in diameter and 4.5 mm (0.18 in.) in length; and of the connector and cable are 1.1 mm (0.04 in.) in diameter and 1995.5 mm (78.6 in.) in length. Construction shall be in accordance with attached Alpha-Omega Services, Inc. Drawing No. CSN00010, Rev. C.
3. Radioactive Contents - No more than 0.555 TBq (15.0 Ci) of Iridium-192. The Ir-192 is in the form of a solid metal wire.
4. Quality Assurance - Records of Quality Assurance activities required by Paragraph 310 of the IAEA regulations¹ shall be maintained and made available to the authorized officials for at least three years after the last shipment authorized by this certificate. Consignors and consignees in the United States exporting or importing shipments under this certificate shall satisfy the requirements of Subpart H of 10 CFR 71.
5. Expiration Date - This certificate expires January 31, 2010.


