This certifies that the source described has been demonstrated to meet the regulatory requirements for special form radioactive material as prescribed in the regulations of the International Atomic Energy Agency<sup>1</sup> and the United States of America<sup>2</sup> for the transport of radioactive material.

1. Source Identification - J.L. Shepherd & Associates Model 6810-150.
2. Source Description - Cylindrical double encapsulation constructed of Type 304L stainless steel and tungsten inert gas welded. Approximate outer dimensions are 19.0 mm (0.748 in.) in diameter and 30.1 mm (1.185 in.) in length. Construction shall be in accordance with attached J.L. Shepherd and Associates Drawing No. A-7025-6810-150.
3. Radioactive Contents - No more than 5.55 TBq (150 Ci) of Cesium-137. The Cs-137 is in the form of pelletized CsCl.
4. Management System Activities - Records of Management System activities required by Paragraph 306 of the IAEA regulations shall be maintained and made available to the authorized officials for at least three years after the last shipment authorized by this certificate. Consignors in the United States exporting shipments under this certificate shall satisfy the requirements of Subpart H of 10 CFR 71.
5. Expiration Date - This certificate expires on January 31, 2023. Previous editions which have not reached their expiration date may continue to be used.

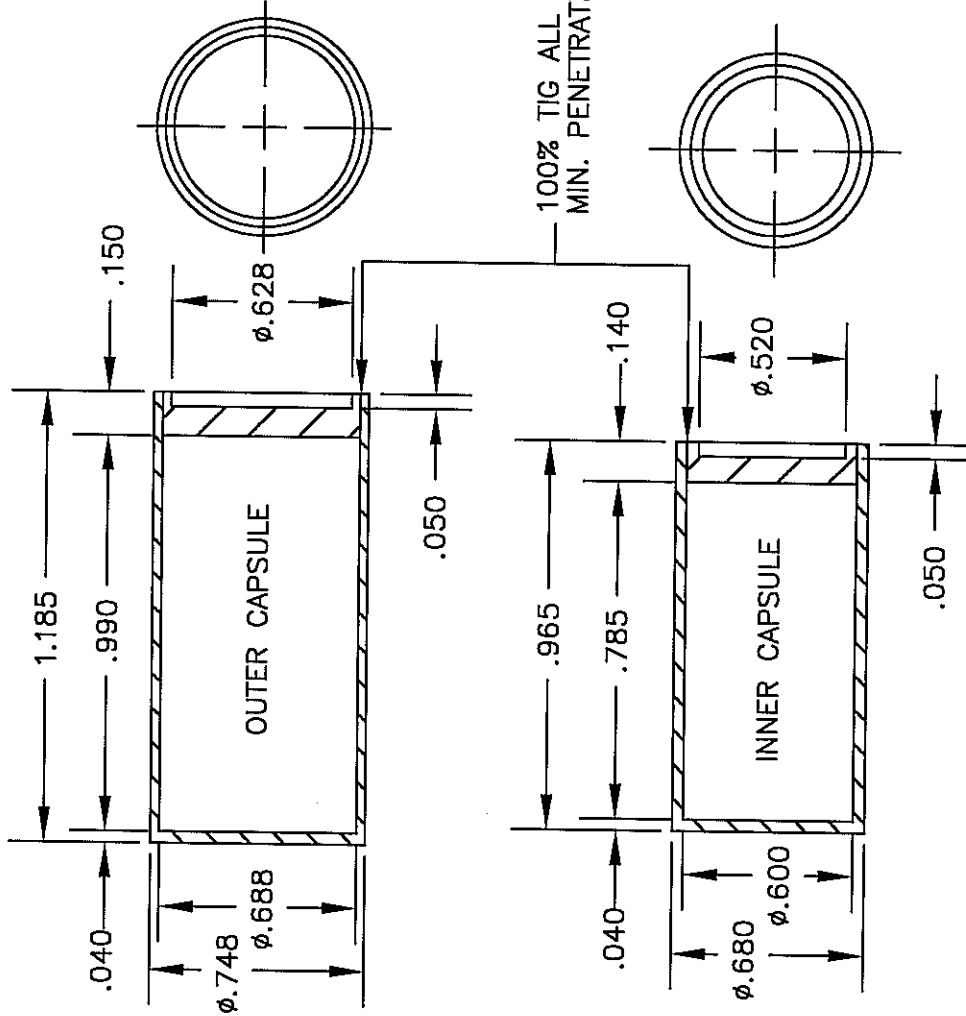
